BAMS/BUMS/BSMS Courses 2022-23- 15 % NRI Admission- Kerala State Indian System of Medicine Self Financing College Management Association (KISMA)- Draft Prospectus submitted for approval- Order issued on 30.12.2022

ORDER

1. The Government of Kerala by order dated 16.11.2022 permitted the self-financing medical colleges which come under Ayush department to fill up 15 % N.R.I seats from the approved annual intake, observing the guidelines/criteria fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee, hereinafter referred to as the Committee.

2. In due compliance of the above direction, the President, Kerala State Indian System of Medicine Self Financing College Management Association (KISMA) submitted a draft prospectus for taking 15% admission under N.R.I quota seats of member colleges that come under the KISMA before this Committee for approval.
3. On preliminary verification of the draft prospectus, it was found that though the President of KISMA has submitted the prospectus before the Committee, the member colleges had not submitted the relevant documents from the competent authorities for conducting the Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani (ASU) courses. Therefore, this Committee directed the President to inform the member colleges to submit the aforesaid documents.
4. In compliance of the above direction, the member colleges of KISMA submitted the affiliation orders obtained from the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) as well as Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) for conducting the ASU courses for the academic year 2022-23.
5. The Committee scrutinised the draft prospectus as well as the notification submitted by the KISMA and the same is hereby provisionally approved subject to the observations and directions given below.

- (i) The President of KISMA shall publish the approved notification for inviting online applications in the electronic media and dailies. No other notification except the one approved shall be published in the dailies.
- (ii) Applications shall be invited by the Member Colleges through online only. No other mode of inviting application shall be entertained.
- (iii) The online application should contain the following information: -
- ❖ Auto generated Registration/ Application Number and auto generated date and time of submission of application.
 - ❖ Facility for uploading the photograph and signature of the candidate.
 - ❖ Category/quota shall be clearly specified in the online application form.
 - ❖ Declaration of the candidate stating that the details furnished in the application are true to the best of knowledge of the applicants shall be included in the online application form.
 - ❖ Facility for taking print outs of the application shall be provided to the candidate by the Medical College.
- (iv) The member colleges of KISMA shall not be entitled to retain the first-year tuition and other fees, if the student discontinues the course before the last date of closing of admission prescribed by the competent authorities. Students who discontinue to course shall be given their qualifying certificates and transfer certificate, on request made by them.

(v) President of the KISMA has included the tentative schedule of ASU courses in the prospectus. Committee has gone through tentative schedule suggested by the KISMA as well as the cut-off date prescribed by the NCISM. After considering the same, the Committee hereby prescribe the tentative admission schedule for taking 15% N.R.I quota for ASU courses for the academic year 2022-2023. If any change is required as regards the dates prescribed by the Committee, the Principal shall obtain prior permission.

(vi) On behalf of the member colleges, the President of KISMA submitted a representation before the Committee on 22.11.2022 wherein it is stated

that the tuition fee and special fee in respect of ASU courses for the academic year 2019-20 were fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee, that the Association did not seek any fee hike in the subsequent academic years and that the Committee permitted the KISMA to collect the tuition fee and special fee for the academic years 2020-21 and 2021-22 at the same rates that were applicable for 2019-20. It is further submitted that they agree to continue the same rate fee of tuition fee and special fee during the academic year 2022-23 also.

- (vii) Considering the representation, the Committee has decided to permit the member colleges that come under the KISMA to collect for the academic year 2022-23, the same rate of tuition fee and special fee fixed by the FRC during the previous academic years.
- (viii) Names of the member colleges and details of the tuition fee and special fee for the academic year are given in Annexure I.
- (ix) Principals of the member colleges shall collect only the approved tuition fee and special fees from the students of ASU courses. The member colleges shall not charge either directly or indirectly any other amount over and above the amount fixed as fee. If any other amount is charged, under any other head or guise the institution will be liable to face penal

action as per the rulings of the Apex Court and the provisions of the Act 15 of 2017.

- (x) Principals of the member colleges are directed to collect the approved tuition fee and special fee only through online payment/cheque/DD/RTGS/IMPS only from the candidates of ASU courses for the academic year 2022-23 onwards.
- (xi) The President, KISMA is directed to include in the prospectus for the academic year 2022-23 the details of the tuition fee and the special fee, as given in Annexure I to this approval order,
- (xii) The principals of the member colleges shall not obtain bonds from the students without the permission of this Committee or the Government.
- (xiii) The member colleges of KISMA are directed to obtain prior approval from the Committee at every stage of the admission procedure.
- (xiv) The President of KISMA is directed to submit the modified prospectus before the Committee after making the above corrections, at the earliest. The modified prospectus alone shall be uploaded in the College website.

Email this order to the President, KISMA and the Principals of the member colleges come under the KISMA.

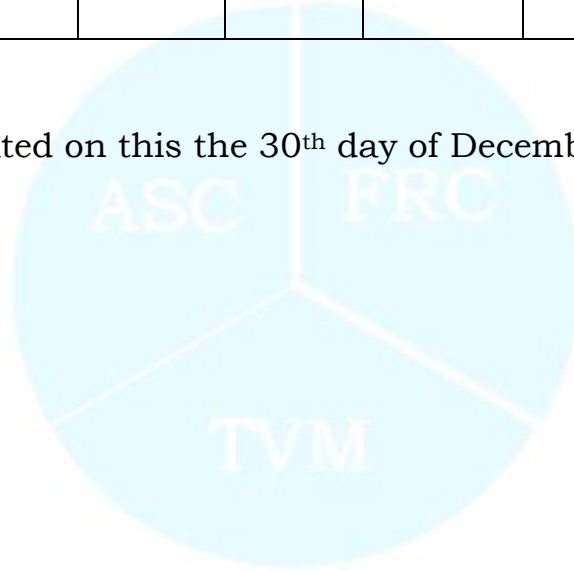
